

SMi Covid Policy

We are looking forward to welcoming you to the 23rd annual Global MilSatCom conference and exhibition. As in previous years, **all attendees** will need to produce **two forms of ID** when registering at the conference. This should include **photo ID and a business card**.

There are also a number of **COVID requirements** from the QEII Conference Centre which also apply to all attendees.

In addition to the two forms of ID outlined above the following will also be required

Attendees coming from the UK

Proof of double vaccination no less than 14 days before attendance (displayed via the NHS app or NHS website). If you aim to take this route, please ensure you register for this in advance to avoid any delays.

- Please note that the NHS app is not the same as the contact tracing app that you use to check into venues. Please note that this is a condition of entry to the Centre

If you do not have proof of double vaccination, you must provide evidence of a negative lateral flow test dated within 48 hours of attendance (reported on the Government website & displayed via text or via the NHS app).

As the conference is three days in duration you will need to carry out two lateral flow tests to attend for all three days

Attendees coming from outside of the UK

International covid passports will need to be shown on entrance
